1 moves to amend the bill on page 223, lines 46 and 47, by adding the following new section
2 between those lines to read:


3 **"EXTEND DEADLINE FOR TWENTY PERCENT REDUCTION OF PETROLEUM**
4 **PRODUCTS USE FOR STATE FLEETS/CLARIFY REPORT REQUIREMENT**

5 **SECTION 20A.5.(a)** Section 19.5(a) of S.L. 2005-276 reads as rewritten:

6 **"SECTION 19.5.(a)** All State agencies, universities, and community colleges that
7 have State-owned vehicle fleets shall develop and implement plans to improve the State's use of
8 alternative fuels, synthetic lubricants, and efficient vehicles. The plans shall achieve a twenty
9 percent (20%) reduction or displacement of the current petroleum products consumed by
10 January 1, 2010. July 1, 2011. Before implementation of any plan, all affected agencies shall
11 report their plan to the Department of Administration. The Department of Administration shall
12 compile a report on the plans submitted and report to the Joint Legislative Commission on
13 Governmental Operations. Agencies shall implement their plans by January 1, 2006.
14 Reductions may be met by petroleum or oils displaced through the use of biodiesel, ethanol,
15 synthetic oils or lubricants, other alternative fuels, the use of hybrid electric vehicles, other
16 fuel-efficient or low-emission vehicles, or additional methods as may be approved by the State
17 Energy Office, thereby reducing the amount of harmful emissions. The plan shall not impede
18 mission fulfillment of the agency and shall specifically address a long-term cost-benefit
19 analysis, allowances for changes in vehicle usage, total miles driven, and exceptions due to
20 technology, budgetary limitations, and emergencies."

21 **SECTION 20A.5.(b)** Section 19.5(c) of S.L. 2005-276 reads as rewritten:

22 **"SECTION 19.5.(c)** Agencies shall report by September 1, 2006, and annually
23 thereafter ~~on September 1, through September 1, 2011~~, to the Department of Administration on
24 the efforts undertaken to achieve the reductions. The Department of Administration shall
25 compile and forward a report to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations
26 by November 1, 2006, and annually thereafter ~~on November 1, through November 1, 2011~~, on
27 the agencies' progress in meeting their plans."
