The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-37.7(d) reads as rewritten:	
"(d) Expiration and Fee A special identification card issued to a person for	the first
time under this section expires when a drivers license issued on the same day to that	t person
would expire. A special identification card renewed under this section expires when	a drivers
license renewed by the card holder on the same day would expire.	
The fee for a special identification card is the same as the fee set in G.S. 20-	14 for a
duplicate license. The fee does not apply to a special identification card issued to a re	sident of
this State who is legally blind, is at least 70 years old, or is homeless. is homeless, or	
been issued a drivers license but the drivers license is cancelled under G.S. 2	0-15, in
accordance with G.S. 20-9(e) and (g), as a result of a physical or mental disability or	disease.
To obtain a special identification card without paying a fee, a homeless person must p	
letter to the Division from the director of a facility that provides care or shelter to h	nomeless
retter to the Division from the director of a facility that provides care of sheller to t	iomeress

persons verifying that the person is homeless."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
