on page 1, line 19, by inserting after that line the following:

9 "(a1) The governing body of the city shall initiate any program under this section by 10 adopting a resolution. The resolution shall do all of the following:

> Briefly but completely describe the proposed program. (1)

Call a special referendum of city voters on the question of adoption of the (2) program. The referendum shall be held and conducted by the county board of elections. The referendum may be held at the same time as any other state, county or municipal primary, election, special election or referendum, or on any date set by the governing body of the city, provided, that the referendum shall not be held within the period of time beginning 60 days before and ending 60 days after any other primary, election, special election or referendum held in the county.

The State Board of Elections shall prescribe procedures for the conduct of the referendum, which the county board of elections shall follow. If the program would be financed with local tax revenues, the proposition on the ballot shall conclude substantially as follows:

"Do you agree to have your local tax dollars used for public financing of local candidates?:

□ YES

□ NO"

If a majority of the votes cast on the proposition are in the affirmative, the governing
