6		SECTION 1. G.S. 20-118(c)(12) reads as rewritten:
7	"(c)	Exceptions. – The following exceptions apply to G.S. 20-118(b) and 20-118(e).
8		
9		(12) Subsections (b) and (e) of this section do not apply to a vehicle that meets all
10		of the conditions set out below:
11		a. Is hauling agricultural crops from the farm where the crop is grown
12		to the closest market any market within 150 miles of that farm.
13		b. Repealed by Session Laws 1993 (Reg. Sess., 1994), c. 761, s. 13.
14		b1. Does not operate on an interstate highway or exceed any posted
15		bridge weight limits during transportation or hauling of agricultural
16		products.
17		c. Does not exceed a single-axle weight of 22,000 pounds, a
18		tandem-axle weight of 42,000 pounds, or a gross weight of 90,000
19		pounds."
20		SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to
21	offenses committed on or after that date.
