| 16 | Article 5 of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes on or after July 1, 2009."                    |
| 17 | <b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 applies to             |
| 18 | applicants for licensure on or after that date.   |
