
1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, lines 42 through 47,
2 by rewriting those lines to read:

4 "(g) Care of Minor Children. -- When a law enforcement officer arrests an adult who is
5 supervising a minor child who is present at the time of arrest, the officer shall proceed as
6 follows:

7 (1) If a parent or guardian of the minor child is available and capable of making
8 the judgment, the officer shall place the minor child with an available
9 responsible person approved by the parent or guardian. This person may be
10 the minor child if the parent is satisfied as to that child's maturity and
11 discretion.

12 (2) If the officer determines that the direction of the parent is not in the best
13 interest of the child, or that no responsible person approved by a parent or
14 guardian is available to supervise the child, or that no parent or guardian is
15 available and capable of making the judgment, then the officer shall do one
16 of the following:

- 17 a. Place the child with another responsible person.
18 b. Leave the child in the child's own custody if the officer is satisfied as
19 to that child's maturity and discretion.
20 c. Contact the county department of social services, which shall
21 determine the best procedure for acting in the best interest of the
22 child."
