9		parent or guardian. This person may be the minor child if the child is at least	
0		16 years old and the parent or guardian is satisfied as to that child's maturity	
1		and discretion.	
2	<u>(2)</u>	If the officer determines that the direction of the parent or guardian is not in	
3		the best interest of the child, or that no responsible person who is at least 16	
4		years old and is approved by a parent or guardian is available to supervise	
5		the child, or that no parent or guardian is available and capable of making	
6		the judgment, then the officer shall do one of the following:	
7		a. Place the child with another responsible person who is at least 16	
8		years old.	
9		b. Leave the child in the child's own custody if the child is at least 16	
0		years old and if the officer is satisfied as to that child's maturity and	
1		discretion.	
2		c. Contact the county department of social services, which shall	
3		determine the best procedure for acting in the best interest of the	
4		child."
