1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF DURHAM TO GRANT THE 3 CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO INCLUDE THE CITY'S MINORITY OR WOMEN'S BUSINESS ENTERPRISE REQUIREMENTS IN THE SPECIFICATIONS 4 5 FOR CITY CONTRACTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 84.1 of the Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671 8 of the 1975 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 474 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as 9 rewritten: 10 "Sec. 84.1. Minority or Women's Business Enterprise Requirements. The City Council may establish, agree to and/or comply with minimum minority 11 (a) 12 and/or women's business enterprise participation requirements in projects financed by public 13 funds to ensure equal employment opportunities and/or to redress past discrimination, by 14 including such minimum requirements in the specifications for contracts to perform all or part 15 of such projects and awarding bids pursuant to G.S. 143-129 and G.S. 143- 131, if applicable, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidder meeting these and other specifications. 16 17 The City Council may delegate to the City Manager or his or her designee the (b) 18 authority to carry out requirements established under subsection (a) of this section in the 19 specifications for contracts to perform all or part of any projects financed by public funds and 20 to award bids to the lowest responsible bidders meeting these and other specifications." 21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
