Representative Blust

1 moves to amend the bill on page 3, line 6, by adding at the end of the line the following:  
2

3 "The consequences and remedial action required under this subdivision for a student who  
4 commits an act of bullying or harassment shall be at least one application of corporal  
5 punishment or a one day suspension for a first offense, three applications of corporal  
6 punishment or a three day suspension for a second offense, and expulsion for one year for a  
7 third offense in those local school administrative units that permit corporal punishment. In a  
8 local school administrative unit that prohibits corporal punishment, the consequences and  
9 remedial action for a student who commits an act of bullying or harassment shall be at least a  
10 one day suspension for a first offense, a three day suspension for a second offense, and  
11 expulsion for one year for a third offense.

12 When dealing with an act of bullying or harassing behavior as defined in this Article, a  
13 teacher or a school administrator may, in his or her discretion, use any degree of force the  
14 teacher or school administrator deems necessary and reasonable, notwithstanding any other  
15 provision of State law that may be to the contrary. A teacher or school administrator shall not  
16 be civilly liable in the courts of this State for the necessary and reasonable actions he or she  
17 takes to enforce this Article."
