6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 115D-39 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
8	"(d) In addition, a resident of a county in Georgia or Tennessee that borders North
9	Carolina is eligible for the resident community college tuition rate in North Carolina if the
10	student's resident state grants the same treatment to residents of North Carolina living in
11	counties bordering that state."
12	SECTION 2. The State Board of Community Colleges shall study the impact of
13	the tuition reciprocity pilot program authorized in Section 1 of this act and shall report the
14	results of the study by August 1, 2012, and by August 1, 2014, to the Joint Legislative
15	Education Oversight Committee.
16	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 of this act
17	applies beginning with the fall semester of the 2009-2010 academic year and expires at the end
18	of the 2013-2014 academic year
