5	SECTION 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a	. new
6	section to read:	
7	"§ 20-49.3. Bureau of License and Theft; custody of seized vehicles.	
8	(a) <u>Vehicles Seized by the Division of Motor Vehicles. – Notwithstanding any</u>	other
9	provision of law, the Division of Motor Vehicles, Bureau of License and Theft, may retai	n any
10	vehicle seized by the Division of Motor Vehicles, Bureau of License and Theft, in the course	rse of
11	any investigation authorized by the provisions of G.S. 20-49 or G.S. 20-49.1 and forfeit	ed to
12	the Division by a court of competent jurisdiction.	
13	(b) Vehicles Seized by the United States Government. – Notwithstanding any	
14	provision of law, the Division may accept custody and ownership of any vehicle seized b	-
15	United States Government, forfeited by a court of competent jurisdiction, and turned over	to the
16	Division.	
17	(c) Use of Vehicles. – All vehicles forfeited to, or accepted by, the Division pursus	
18	this section shall be used by the Bureau of License and Theft to conduct undercover operation	<u>itions</u>
19	and inspection station compliance checks throughout the State.	
20	(d) Disposition of Seized Vehicles. – Upon determination by the Commission	
21	Motor Vehicles that a vehicle transferred pursuant to the provisions of this section is	
22	further use to the agency for use in official investigations, the vehicle shall be sold as su	_
23	property in the same manner as other vehicles owned by the law enforcement agency and	
24	proceeds from the sale after deducting the cost of sale shall be paid to the treasurer or p	-
25	officer authorized to receive fines and forfeitures to be used for the school fund of the cour	
26	the county in which the vehicle was seized, provided, that any vehicle transferred to any	
27	enforcement agency under the provisions of this Article that has been modified to inc	
28	speed shall be used in the performance of official duties only and not for resale, transf	
29	disposition other than as junk. Any vehicle seized outside of this State shall be sold as su	
30	property in the same manner as other vehicles owned by the law enforcement agency and	
31	proceeds from the sale after deducting the cost of sale shall be paid to the treasurer and p	laced
32 33	in the Civil Fines and Forfeitures Fund established pursuant to G.S. 115C-457.1." SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
