SECTION 30.11. Notwithstanding G.S. 136-253 and any other provision of law, funds from the General Fund shall not be used to fund the North Carolina International Terminal of the North Carolina State Ports Authority. This section does not apply to the use of agency receipts."; and

On page 139, line 42, by inserting a new subsection to read:

21 22 23 "SECTION 30.2.(d) Notwithstanding the provisions of Item 1 on Page M-1 of the Report on the Continuation, Expansion and Capital Budgets, dated June 2, 2010, the funds allocated in this section shall provide a State match for an estimated twenty-seven million three hundred thousand dollars (\$27,300,000) in federal funds."
