1 moves to amend the bill on page 11, line 44, by rewriting the line to read:

2 **"IMPLEMENT ZERO BASED BUDGETING BY JULY 1, 2011**

3 **SECTION 6.4A.** The General Assembly finds that the traditional method of
4 budgeting is no longer sufficient for fiscal year 2011-2012 due to these challenging economic
5 times.

6 To provide for prudent financial management during the State's growing financial
7 crisis, it is necessary to begin baseline implementation of zero based budgeting during the
8 2010-2011 fiscal year, with a complete conversion to zero based budgeting for fiscal year
9 2011-2012. To that end, effective January 1, 2011, The Office of State Budget and
10 Management shall begin subjecting every program in State government to a zero-based budget.

11 Effective July 1, 2011, the North Carolina State Budget shall not operate as a
12 recurring baseline budget and all accounts shall revert to zero pending action by the 2011
13 General Assembly."
