6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 132-1.10 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
7	"(f1) Without a request made pursuant to subsection (f) of this section, a register of deeds
8	or clerk of court may remove from an image or copy of an official record placed on a register of
9	deeds' or clerk of court's Internet Web site available to the general public, or placed on an
10	Internet Web site available to the general public used by a register of deeds or clerk of court to
11	display public records, a person's social security, employer taxpayer identification, drivers
12	license, State identification, passport, checking account, savings account, credit card, debit card
13	number, date of birth, or personal identification (PIN) code or passwords contained in that
14	official record."
15	<b>SECTION 2.(a)</b> G.S. 132-1.10 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
16	"(f2) Registers of deeds and clerks of court shall apply optical character recognition
17	technology and other reasonably available technology to official records placed on Internet
18	Web sites available to the general public in order to, in good faith, identify and redact social
19 20	security and drivers license numbers."
20 21	<ul><li>SECTION 2.(b) G.S. 132-1.10(h) reads as rewritten:</li><li>"(h) Any affected person may petition the court for an order directing compliance with</li></ul>
21	this section. No liability shall accrue to a register of deeds or clerk of court or to his or her
22	agent for any action related to provisions of this section or for any claims or damages that
23 24	might result from a social security number or other identifying information on the public record
25	or on a register of deeds' or clerk of court's Internet Web site available to the general public or
26	an Internet Web site available to the general public used by a register of deeds or clerk of <del>court.</del>
27	court, provided a register of deeds or clerk of court complies with subsection (f2) of this
28	section."
29	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2011. The remainder
30	of this act is effective when it becomes law.
