| 3 | MOUNT TO EXERCISE THE POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO ACQUIRE |
| 4 | CERTAIN SUBSTANDARD RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY TO PROVIDE HOUSING |
| 5 | FOR LOW AND MODERATE INCOME PERSONS. |
| 6 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 7 | SECTION 1. Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by |
| 8 | adding the following new section to read: |
| 9 | "§ 160A-450.1. Acquisition of property by eminent domain. |
| 10 | For the purpose of providing housing for low and moderate income persons, a municipality |
| 11 | shall have the power of eminent domain to acquire vacant dwellings that have been closed for |
| 12 | human habitation as a result of housing code violations for a minimum period of two years and |
| 13 | to acquire the lot or tract upon which the vacant dwellings are situated. Any conveyance by the |
| 14 | city of property acquired pursuant to this section shall contain a restriction limiting the use of |
| 15 | that property to the provision of housing for low and moderate income persons as defined in |
| 16 | this section. For purposes of this section, the phrase "low and moderate income" means annual |
| 17 | gross income equal to or less than eighty percent (80%) of the median household income for |
| 18 | the Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) of which the municipality is a part, adjusted for |
| 19 | household size, and as that phrase may be revised periodically by the United States Department |
| 20 | of Housing and Urban Development. In the exercise of its authority of eminent domain for the |
| 21 | acquisition of property to provide housing for low and moderate income persons, the |
| 22 | municipality shall follow the procedures prescribed in Chapter 40A of the General Statutes. |
| 23 | The governing body of the municipality shall adopt a plan to use condemned property for low |
| 24 | or moderate income housing prior to exercising the powers authorized under this section. The |
| 25 | power of eminent domain under this section may be used only when the vacant dwelling would |
| 26 | otherwise be demolished under the municipality's housing code." |
| 27 | SECTION 2. This act applies to the City of Winston-Salem and the City of Rocky |
| 28 | Mount only. |

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- **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
