6	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Part 2 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended		
7	by adding a new section to read:		
8	"§ 116-34.2. Institute of Management Innovation established.		
9	The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall establish the Institute of		
10	Management Innovation within the Department of Political Science and Public Affairs at		
11	Western Carolina University to conduct research regarding best practices in management and		
12	act as a resource for the North Carolina Office of Management Innovation, established in		
13	Article 3E of Chapter 147 of the General Statutes."		
14	SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State		
15	Budget and Management the sum of one million sixty-eight thousand dollars (\$1,068,000) for		
16	the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of one million sixty-eight thousand dollars (\$1,068,000)		
17	for the 2010-2011 fiscal year for the support of the Office of Management Innovation. There is		
18	appropriated from the General Fund to The University of North Carolina the sum of two		
19	hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of two		
20	hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year for the support of the		
21	Institute of Management Innovation at Western Carolina University.		
22	<b>SECTION 5.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
