cut down, in	ijure or remove any standing, growing or fallen tree or log,	-log off the property of
another, he	the person shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. pu	inished the same as in
G.S. 14-72.		
<u>(b)</u> <u>S</u>	Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to a lessee of p	property who removes a
fallen tree or	r log that poses an imminent threat to persons or property."	
S	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1,	2009, and applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
