10	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
11	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-207 reads as rewritten:		
12	"§ 115C-207. Authority and responsibility of local boards of education.		
13	Every local board of education that uses State funds to implement programs under this		
14	Article shall:		
15	(1)	Develop programs and plans for increased community involvement in the	
16		public schools based upon policies and guidelines adopted by the State	
17		Board of Education.	
18	<u>(1a)</u>	Develop policies and programs designed to encourage the use of	
19		community-based academic booster organizations, which may be known as	
20		Community Achievement Network – Developing Our Educational	
21		Resources (CAN DOER) organizations, to provide tutoring and other	
22		appropriate services to encourage and support student academic	
23		achievement.	
24	<u>(1b)</u>	Develop policies and/or procedures for approving the use of volunteer	
25		organizations and for approving the use of individual volunteers.	
26	<u>(1c)</u>	Develop policies and/or procedures designed to make information available	
27		to parents and students about what tutoring and other academic support	
28		services are available to students in the community or through school	
29		volunteers or other community organizations.	
30	(2)	Develop programs and plans for increased community use of public school	
31		facilities based upon policies and guidelines adopted by the State Board of	
32		Education.

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Establish rules governing the implementation of such programs and plans in its public schools and submit these rules along with adopted programs and plans to the State Board of Education for approval by the State Board of Education.

Programs and plans developed by a local board of education may provide for the establishment of one or more community schools advisory councils for the public schools under the board's jurisdiction and for the employment of one or more community schools coordinators. The local board of education shall establish the terms and conditions of employment for the community schools coordinators.

Every local board of education using State funds to implement a community schools program under this Article may enter into agreements with other local boards of education, agencies and institutions for the joint development of plans and programs and the joint expenditure of these State funds."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
