3 "(3) Establish as long-term minimum goals Statewide four-year cohort graduation rates of
4 seventy-four percent (74%) by 2014; eighty percent (80%) by 2016; and ninety percent (90%)
5 by 2018."; and

7 On lines 24-25 by inserting the following between the lines:

9 "The State Board of Education shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight
10 Committee by November 15, 2010 and annually thereafter on the goals, benchmarks, and
11 recommendations described in this section. Such goals, benchmarks, and recommendations
12 shall appropriately differentiate for students with disabilities and other specially identified
13 subcategories within each four-year cohort. The report shall include goals and benchmarks by
14 local school administrative unit, the strategies and recommendations for achieving the goals
15 and benchmarks, any evidence or data supporting the strategies and recommendations, and the
16 identity of the persons employed by the State Board of Education who are responsible for
17 oversight of local school administrative units in achieving the goals and benchmarks."
