The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 3 of S.L. 2003-240, as amended by S.L. 2007-330, a	reads as
rewritten:	
"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act applies to the <u>City of Fayetteville and the To</u>	owns of
Boiling Springs, Carolina Beach, and Wrightsville Beach only.	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> Section 1 of S.L. 2003-240 reads as rewritten:	
"SECTION 1. The council of a city may provide, by ordinance, for the use of whe	el locks
on illegally parked vehicles within the designated area, for which there are three or	or more
outstanding, unpaid, and overdue parking tickets issued on at least three separate da	ys. The
ordinance shall provide for notice or warning to be affixed to the vehicle, notice to be	sent to
the registered owner of the vehicle by mail, immobilization, towing, impoundment,	appeal
hearing, an immobilization fee not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), and charges for tow	ing and
storage. The city shall not be responsible for any damage to an immobilized illegally	parked
vehicle resulting from unauthorized attempts to free or move that vehicle."	-
<b>SECTION 3.</b> Section 2 of this act applies to the City of Fayetteville only.	
<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
