The conferees appointed to resolve the differences between the Senate and the House of Representatives on Senate Bill 863, A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF CREDITABLE SERVICE BY MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR CERTAIN PERIODS OF NONQUALIFIED EMPLOYMENT, Pensions & Retirement & Aging Committee Substitute Adopted 4/22/09, submit the following report:

The House recedes from House Amendment #1, and the House and Senate agree to the following amendment:

On page 1, line 24, by rewriting the line to read:

"SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and applies to nonqualified employment with an economic development organization performed on or before December 31, 2009. This act expires December 31, 2009, provided that any inchoate rights that may accrue to a member under this act shall not be diminished."



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
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
The conferees recommend that the Senate and the House of Representatives adopt this report.






