9 "(33) Duty to Develop Recommended Programs for Use in Schools on Memorial  
10 Day. - The State Board of Education shall develop recommended  
11 instructional programs that enable students to gain a better understanding of  
12 the meaning and importance of Memorial Day. All schools, especially  
13 schools that hold school on Memorial Day, shall ~~recognize~~ instruct students  
14 on the significance of Memorial Day."

15 "SECTION 4.(b) The State Board of Education shall report to the Joint Legislative  
16 Education Oversight Committee by January 15, 2011, on the instructional programs developed  
17 in accordance with G.S. 115C-12(33), as rewritten by subsection (a) of this section.";
