PARKING FACILITIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-301(a) reads as rewritten:	
"(a) On-Street Parking A city may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and proh	
parking of vehicles on the public streets, alleys, and bridges within the city. When pa	_
permitted for a specified period of time at a particular location, a city may install a	
meter at that location and require any person parking a vehicle therein to place the re-	
operation for the entire time that the vehicle remains in that location, up to the maximu allowed for parking there. Parking meters may be activated by coins or tokens.coins,	
credit cards, or electronic means. A city may establish parking zones within the city a	
require a different monetary amount to activate the meter for different time periods base	
the zone in which the meter is located. Proceeds from the use of parking meters or	
streets must be used to defray the cost of enforcing and administering traffic and	-
ordinances and regulations.operating the parking program or providing parking facilities	
SECTION 2. This act applies to the Cities of Raleigh and Wilmington	and the



Towns of Chapel Hill, Wrightsville Beach, Carolina Beach, and Kure Beach only.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
