18 "(4e) Any district attorney or assistant district attorney who carries or possesses a  
19 concealed handgun in any portion of a building housing a court of the  
20 General Court of Justice other than a courtroom itself, if the district attorney  
21 or assistant district attorney (i) is in the building to discharge their official  
22 duties, (ii) has a concealed handgun permit issued in accordance with Article  
23 54B of this Chapter or considered valid under G.S. 14-415.24, (iii) has  
24 successfully completed weapons retention training substantially similar to  
25 that provided to certified law enforcement officers in North Carolina, and  
26 (iv) secures the weapon in a locked compartment when the weapon is not on  
27 their person."


