"(4e) Any district attorney or assistant district attorney who carries or possesses a concealed handgun in any portion of a building housing a court of the General Court of Justice other than a courtroom itself, if the district attorney or assistant district attorney (i) is in the building to discharge their official duties, (ii) has a concealed handgun permit issued in accordance with Article 54B of this Chapter or considered valid under G.S. 14-415.24, (iii) has successfully completed weapons retention training substantially similar to that provided to certified law enforcement officers in North Carolina, and (iv) secures the weapon in a locked compartment when the weapon is not on their person,".
