8	from noncertified sources as that are available under State term contracts, su	bject to the	
9	following conditions:		
10	(1) The purchase price, including the cost of delivery, is less than the	ne cost under	
11	the State term contract; and		
12	(2) The cost of the purchase shall not exceed the bid value	benchmark	
13	established under G.S. 143-53.1.G.S. 143-53.1; and		
14	(3) The items are the same or substantially similar in quality,	service, and	
15	performance as items available under State term contracts.		
16	(a1) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, a community college m	• •	
17	in any lawful manner, an item that is neither available under State term contracts nor		
18	substantially similar to an item available under State term contracts.		
19	(b) The State Board of Community Colleges and the Department of Administration		
20	shall jointly adopt policies and procedures for monitoring the implementation of this		
21	section, including without limitation (i) definitions of substantial similarity, (ii) the		
22	content and frequency of reports and audits of such purchases, and (iii) a process for		
23	any term contract existing as of October 1, 2009, with respect to which the exercise of		
24 25	purchasing flexibility could constitute a breach of that contract. In the formation of each new term contract entered into after October 1, 2009, the		
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26 27	Department of Administration shall, in its discretion, either provide in the contract for the purchasing flexibility set out in this section or make the term contract inapplicable to

28 29	(c) The State Board of Community Colleges, in consultation with the D	enartment of	
2) 30	Administration, shall review the purchasing process for community colleges and a	-	
31	or decrease the purchasing/delegation benchmark for each community college based on the		
32	college's overall capabilities, including staff resources, purchasing compliance		
33	audit reports. The State Board may, in its discretion, reduce a commun		
34	purchasing/delegation benchmark at anytime. The State Board shall not increase a

- 1 <u>college's purchasing/delegation benchmark by more than fifteen percent (15%) in any calendar</u>
- 2 year without the concurrence of the Department of Administration within 60 days of
- 3 <u>submission</u>. The maximum purchasing/delegation benchmark for a community college shall be
- 4 <u>one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).</u>"
- 5 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
