3	TO KEEP ADDITIONAL RECORDS AND TO FILE AN INVENTORY REPORT WITH

6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:						
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-62.1(a) reads as rewritten:						
8	"(a) Records for Scrap or Parts A secondary metals recycler, as defined in						
9	G.S. 66-11(a)(3), and a salvage yard, as defined in G.S. 20-137.7(6), purchasing motor vehicles						
10	solely for the purposes of dismantling or wrecking such motor vehicles for the recovery of						
11	scrap metal or for the sale of parts only, must comply with the provision of G.S. 20-61,						
12	provided, however, that a secondary metals recycler or salvage yard may purchase a motor						
13	vehicle without a certificate of title, if the motor vehicle is 10 model years old or older and the						
14	secondary metals recycler or salvage yard comply with the following requirements:						
15	(1) Maintain a record of all purchase transactions of motor vehicles. The						
16	following information shall be maintained for transactions of motor vehicles:						
17	a.	The name and address of the secondary metals recycler or salvage					
18		yard.					
19	b.	The name, initials, or other identification of the individual entering					
20		the information.					
21	с.	The date of the transaction.					
22	d.	A description of the motor vehicle, including the make and model to					
23		the extent practicable.					
24	e.	The vehicle identification number (VIN) of the vehicle.					
25	f.	The amount of consideration given for the motor vehicle.					
26	g.	A written statement signed by the seller or the seller's agent					
27		certifying that the seller or the seller's agent has the lawful right to					
28		sell and dispose of the motor vehicle.					
29	h.	The name and address of the person from whom the motor vehicle is					
30		being purchased.purchased and the license plate number and state of					
31		issuance of the vehicle used to deliver the vehicle being sold.					
32	i.	A photocopy or electronic scan of a valid drivers license or					
33		identification card issued by the Division of Motor Vehicles of the					
34		seller of the motor vehicle, or seller's agent, to the secondary metals
