2 by inserting between the lines the following:

3 "(4) Notwithstanding any local government ordinance to the contrary, an
4 enclosed area of a restaurant or bar in which no employee is younger than 18
5 years old if smoke does not migrate into an enclosed area in which smoking
6 is prohibited pursuant to this Article, and which conspicuously posts signs at
7 all entrances and provides notice in all advertising and employment
8 materials stating that smoking is permitted."; and

10 further moves to amend the bill on page 5, lines 47 and 48
11 by inserting between the lines the following:

12 "(9) Notwithstanding any local government ordinance to the contrary, an
13 enclosed area of a restaurant or bar in which no employee is younger than 18
14 years old if smoke does not migrate into an enclosed area in which smoking
15 is prohibited pursuant to this Article, and which conspicuously posts signs at
16 all entrances and provides notice in all advertising and employment
17 materials stating that smoking is permitted.

18 (10) A public place other than a restaurant or bar that is under the control of a
19 private employer."
