AN ACT TO MAKE FURTHER AMENDMENTS TO THE SULLIVAN ACT, AND TO
ALLOW THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE TO USE REVENUES FOR STREET AND
SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH WATERLINE
IMPROVEMENTS.
Whereas, the General Assembly previously adopted Chapter 399 of the 1933
Public-Local Laws (known as the "Sullivan Act") to address the particular circumstances of the
supplying of water to certain residents of Buncombe County by the City of Asheville and the
charges therefor; and
Whereas, the 2005 General Assembly made further amendments to the Sullivan Act
with the enactment of S.L. 2005-139 and S.L. 2005-140; Now, therefore,
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. The City of Asheville may use up to five percent (5%) of utility
revenues for street and sidewalk improvements associated with waterline improvements.
•
SECTION 2. This act applies to the City of Asheville only.
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
