(b) The report required under subsection (a) of this section shall contain the following information:"; And on page 2, lines 43-45, by rewriting the lines to read: "(d) The term "settlement" for the purpose of this section includes a payment made from personal funds, a payment by a third party on behalf of the physician or physician assistant, or a payment from any other source of funds."
