The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. Unless a person owns or possesses a lease	chold interest in the real
property immediately adjacent to the portion of the road on which th	e person is located, it is
unlawful for that person to discharge a firearm from, on, or across t	he right-of-way of State
Secondary Road 1862, known as Joyner Drive, from Adams Creek	Road to the end of the
State-maintained portion of the road.	
SECTION 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeano	r.
SECTION 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement	officers of the Wildlife
Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by pea	ce officers with general
subject matter jurisdiction.	
SECTION 4. This act applies only to Craven County.	

SECTION 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
