<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 115C-81 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(e2) Honors-Level Courses in Health and Physical Education to be Developed an
Administered The State Board of Education shall develop or identify academically rigorou
honors-level courses in health education and physical education that can be offered at the hig
school level. These honors-level courses shall be more rigorous than standard-level courses
include advanced content, provide multiple opportunities for students to take greate
responsibility for their learning, and require higher quality work from the students tha
standard courses."
