G.S. 1C-1601(a)(1) reads as rewritten: nat property exempt; waiver; exceptions. pt property. – Each individual, resident of this State, who is a debtor is entitled the enforcement of the claims of creditors: The debtor's aggregate interest, not to exceed eighteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$18,500)thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) in value, in real property or personal property that the debtor or a dependent of the debtor uses as a residence, in a cooperative that owns property that the debtor or a dependent of the debtor; however, an unmarried debtor who is 65 years of age or older is entitled to retain an aggregate interest in the property not to exceed thirty seven thousand dollars (\$37,000)sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) in value so long as the property was previously owned by the debtor as a tenant by the entireties or as a joint tenant with rights of survivorship and the former co-owner of the property is deceased.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009.
