"seven days after completion of grading. For an area of land-disturbing activity where grading activities have not been completed, temporary groundcover shall be provided as follows:

- a. For an area with no slope, temporary groundcover shall be provided for the area if it has not been disturbed for a period of 14 days.
- b. For an area of moderate slope, temporary groundcover shall be provided for the area if it has not been disturbed for a period of 10 days. For purposes of this subdivision, "moderate slope" means an inclined area, the inclination of which is less than or equal to 3 units of horizontal distance to 1 unit of vertical distance.
- c. For an area of steep slope, temporary groundcover shall be provided for the area if it has not been disturbed for a period of seven days. For purposes of this subdivision, "steep slope" means an inclined area, the inclination of which is greater than 3 units of horizontal distance to 1 unit of vertical distance."
