A release made pursuant to this 11 subsection may be pleaded in bar of any action or proceeding for the recovery of the rights 12 13 released." 14 SECTION 2. G.S. 50-16.6(b) reads as rewritten: 15 Alimony, postseparation support, and counsel fees may be barred by an express "(b) provision of a valid separation agreement or premarital agreement agreement, premarital 16 17 agreement, or marital contract made pursuant to G.S. 52-10(a1) so long as the agreement is 18 performed." 19 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
