2	fee for electronic filing. Fees charged for the processing of an electronic filing are in addition to
3	any other fee imposed for the filing. Fees charged for an electronic filing are limited to the
4	actual cost of the electronic transaction.
5	(d) This section does not supersede any other provision of law that requires the
6	electronic filing of a document or requires an applicant for a license or a licensee to make any
7	other filing electronically."
8	SECTION 3. G.S. 58-33-40(b) reads as rewritten:
9	"(b) Any insurer authorized to transact business in this State may appoint as its agent any
10	individual who holds a valid agent's license issued by the Commissioner. Upon the
11	appointment, the individual shall be authorized to act as an agent for the appointing insurer for
12	all-the kinds of insurance for which the insurer is authorized in this State and for which the
13	appointed agent is licensed in this State, unless specifically limited. For purposes of
14	determining the number of appointments for an agent, there shall be one appointment for each
15	kind of insurance for which the appointed agent is licensed in this State, unless specifically
16	limited."
17	SECTION 4. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
