(8) Social Worker. – A person engaging in the practice of social work wh not certified or licensed under this Chapter as a Certified Social Worker, Certified Master Social Worker, Licensed Clinical Social Worker, Certified Social Work Manager.certified, licensed, or provisionally licensed by this Chapter or otherwise exempt under G.S. 90B-10." SECTION 3. Chapter 90B of the General Statutes is amended by adding following new section to read: "§ 90B-16. Title protection. (a) Except as provided in G.S. 90B-10, an individual who (i) is not certified, licen or provisionally licensed by this Chapter as a social worker, (ii) does not hold a bachelor master's degree in social work from a college or university having a social work prograceredited or admitted to candidacy for accreditation by the Council of Social Work Educator (iii) has not received a doctorate in social work, shall not use the title 'Social Worker' or	nsed, 's or gram tion,
