Senator Berger of Franklin

moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 3 by rewriting that line to read:

"2009, AND EXPANDING THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH 911 FUNDS MAY BE USED BY PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINTS.";

And on page 4, line 33 by rewriting that line to read:

"SECTION 7. G.S. 62A-46(c) reads as rewritten:

- Use of Funds. A PSAP that receives a distribution from the 911 Fund may not use the amount received to pay for the lease or purchase of real estate, cosmetic remodeling of emergency dispatch centers, hiring or compensating telecommunicators, or the purchase of mobile communications vehicles, ambulances, fire engines, or other emergency vehicles. Distributions received by a PSAP may be used only to pay for the following:
 - The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone equipment, (1) including necessary computer hardware, software, and database provisioning, addressing, and nonrecurring costs of establishing a 911 system.system, the lease, purchase, and maintenance of consoles and telephone and communications equipment owned or operated and physically located within and for the use of the 911 public safety communications center, and the lease, purchase, and maintenance of an additional communications tower, a multisite simulcast system, microwave connectivity between the sites, site monitoring and alarm system, base stations, and grounding and lightning protection for any of the uses authorized by this subdivision.
 - Expenditures for in-State training of 911 personnel regarding the (2) maintenance and operation of the 911 system. Allowable training expenses include the cost of transportation, lodging, instructors, certifications, improvement programs, quality assurance training, and training associated with call taking, and emergency medical, fire, or law enforcement procedures. Training outside the State is not an eligible expenditure unless the training is unavailable in the State or the PSAP documents that the training costs are less if received out-of-state. Training specific to the receipt of 911 calls is allowed only for intake and related call taking quality assurance and improvement. Instructor certification costs and course required prerequisites, including physicals, psychological exams, and drug testing, are not allowable expenditures.
