## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF BROADBAND SERVICE AND TO 3 PROVIDE THAT THE CONSUMER COMPLAINT PROCEDURE OVERSEEN BY THE 4 PUBLIC STAFF OF THE UTILITIES COMMISSION IS NOT REGULATION UNDER 5 CHAPTER 62.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 62-2(b1) reads as rewritten:

7 8 "(b1) Broadband service provided by public utilities as defined in G.S. 62-3(23)a.6. is 9 sufficiently competitive and shall not be regulated by the Commission. The complaint procedure provided under G.S. 62-73.1 is not considered regulation under this subsection. 10 Nothing herein shall be construed to (i) modify the authority of any entity to enforce applicable 11 12 State or federal statutes or regulations relating to switched access rates or other intercarrier 13 compensation rates for interexchange services provided by a local exchange telecommunications company or (ii) modify any authority of the State or a political subdivision 14 15 thereof with respect to cable services consistent with Title VI of the Communications Act of 1934 (47 United States Code Section 521, et seq.) and with Article 42 of Chapter 66 of the 16 17 General Statutes."

SECTION 2. G.S. 62-3(1) reads as rewritten:

"Broadband service" means any service that consists of or includes a 19 "(1) high-speed access capability to transmit at a rate of not less than 200 kilobits 20 21 per second in either the upstream or downstream direction and either (i) is used to provide access to the Internet, or (ii) provides computer processing, 22 information storage, information content, or protocol conversion, including 23 any service applications or information service provided over such 24 high-speed access service. shall have the same definition as the most current 25 definition adopted by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in its 26 27 rules and regulations. Unless otherwise defined by the FCC, "broadband service" shall not include any service that enables the end user to send or 28 receive communications in Internet protocol or a successor protocol 29 including, but not limited to, Voice-over-Internet protocol. "Broadband 30 service" does not include intrastate service that was tariffed by the 31 32 Commission and in effect as of the effective date of this subdivision. For the purposes of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes and Article 42 of Chapter 33 66 of the General Statutes, "broadband service" does not include any cable 34

3	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
