- 2 AN ACT TO SET A NEW MINIMUM FILING FEE FOR BOARD OF EDUCATION 3 CANDIDACY.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5

SECTION 1. G.S. 163-294.2(e) reads as rewritten:

6 The Except for boards of education elected on a nonpartisan basis, the filing fee for "(e) 7 the primary or election shall be fixed by the governing board not later than the day before 8 candidates are permitted to begin filing notices of candidacy. There shall be a minimum filing 9 fee of five dollars (\$5.00). The governing board shall have the authority to set the filing fee at 10 not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than one percent (1%) of the annual salary of the office sought unless one percent (1%) of the annual salary of the office sought is less than five 11 12 dollars (\$5.00), in which case the minimum filing fee of five dollars (\$5.00) will be charged. 13 The filing fee for boards of education elected on a nonpartisan basis shall be one percent (1%) 14 of the annual salary of the office sought or twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), whichever is greater. The fee shall be paid to the board of elections at the time notice of candidacy is filed." 15

SECTION 2. G.S. 163-291(3) reads as rewritten:

17 "§ 163-291. Partisan primaries and elections.

18 The nomination of candidates for office in cities, towns, villages, and special districts 19 whose elections are conducted on a partisan basis shall be governed by the provisions of this 20 Chapter applicable to the nomination of county officers, and the terms "county board of elections," "chairman of the county board of elections," "county officers," and similar terms 21 shall be construed with respect to municipal elections to mean the appropriate municipal 22 23 officers and candidates, except that:
