1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT DESIGNATING THE COLONIAL SPANISH MUSTANG AS THE OFFICIAL
3	HORSE OF THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA.
4	Whereas, the wild horses living along the Outer Banks of North Carolina are
5	considered to be descendants of the horses brought to the Americas by Spanish explorers and
6	colonists beginning in the 16 <sup>th</sup> century; and
7	Whereas, these horses are known as Colonial Spanish Mustangs; and
8	Whereas, these Colonial Spanish Mustangs have played a significant role in the
9	history and culture of North Carolina's coastal area for hundreds of years; Now, therefore,
10	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
11	SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
12	section to read:
13	" <u>§ 145-31. State horse.</u>
14	The Colonial Spanish Mustang is adopted as the official horse of the State of North
15	<u>Carolina.</u> "
16	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
