7 "(f) The court may grant one or more of the following forms of relief in a permanent no  
8 contact order under this Article:

- 9 (1) Order the defendant not to threaten, visit, assault, molest, or otherwise  
10 interfere with the victim.
- 11 (2) Order the defendant not to follow the victim, including at the victim's  
12 workplace.
- 13 (3) Order the defendant not to harass the victim.
- 14 (4) Order the defendant not to abuse or injure the victim.
- 15 (5) Order the defendant not to contact the victim by telephone, written  
16 communication, or electronic means.
- 17 (6) Order the defendant to refrain from entering or remaining present at the  
18 victim's residence, school, place of employment, or other specified places at  
19 times when the victim is present.
- 20 (7) Order other relief deemed necessary and appropriate by the court.

21 (g) A permanent no contact order entered pursuant to this Article shall be enforced by  
22 all North Carolina law enforcement agencies without further order of the court. A law  
23 enforcement officer shall arrest and take a person into custody without a warrant or other  
24 process if the officer has probable cause to believe that the person knowingly has violated a  
25 permanent no contact order. A person who knowingly violates a permanent no contact order is  
26 guilty of a Class A1 misdemeanor.

27 (h) The remedy provided by this Article is not exclusive but is in addition to other  
28 remedies provided under law."






