4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Article 16 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 14-72.8. Larceny of motor vehicle parts.</u>
8	(a) Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater
9	punishment, larceny of a motor vehicle part valued at one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or less may
10	be punished as follows:
11	(1) For a first offense under this subsection, a person is guilty of a Class 1
12	misdemeanor.
13	(2) For a second or subsequent offense under this subsection, a person is guilty
14	<u>of a Class I felony.</u>
15	(b) Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater
16	punishment, larceny of a motor vehicle part valued at more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000)
17	may be punished as follows:
18	(1) For a first offense under this subsection, a person is guilty of a Class H
19	felony.
20	(2) For a second or subsequent offense under this subsection, a person is guilty
21	of a Class G felony."
22	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to
23	offenses committed on or after that date.
