2	AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF LARCENY OF A MOTOR
3	VEHICLE PART.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Article 16 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 14-72.8. Felony larceny of motor vehicle parts.</u>
8	Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater
9	punishment, larceny of a motor vehicle part is a Class I felony if the cost of repairing the motor
10	vehicle is one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more.
11	For purposes of this section, the cost of repairing a motor vehicle means the cost of any
12	replacement part and any additional costs necessary to install the replacement part in the motor
13	vehicle."
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to
15	offenses committed on or after that date.
