SECTION 1. G.S. 14-415.1 is amended by adding a new subsection	to read:
"(d) This section does not apply and there is no disentitlement under thi	s section if the
felony conviction is a violation under the laws of North Carolina, another state	or the United
States that pertains to antitrust violations, unfair trade practices, restraints of	trade, or other
similar offenses relating to the regulation of business practices."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009. Proceedings of the second of	
offenses committed before the effective date of this act are not abated or affect	
and the statutes that would be applicable but for this act remain applicable	cable to those
prosecutions.
