| <u>(9</u>   | A sheriff or a designated deputy sheriff who is assigned to investigate the diversion and illegal use of prescription medication or pharmaceutic products identified in Article 5 of this Chapter of the General Statutes. Schedule II through V controlled substances, provided that the sheriff designated deputy sheriff has a reasonable suspicion in a specified investigation relating to the enforcement of laws governing licit drugs. The sheriff or designated deputy sheriff shall notify the Office of the Attornational Control of North Carolina of each request for inspection of recommunication by the Department." |
