1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 31-31, by rewriting those lines to read: 2 3 4 "SECTION 3. Chapter 126 of the General Statutes in amended by adding a new 5 subsection to read: 6 "Article 17. 7 Equal Access. 8 "§ 126-100. Equal access for all State and local government employee associations. 9 It is the intent of the General Assembly that all State and local government 10 employee associations have equal access to employees at workplaces and that State and local 11 government employers not favor nor endorse an employee association; therefore, neither a State nor a local government employer shall do any of the following: 12 13 (1) Grant access to employees' physical or electronic mailboxes to a State or 14 local government employee association unless it gives such access to all 15 State or local government employee associations operating in the State. (2)Permit a State or local government employee association to attend new 16 17 employee orientations to recruit members unless it permits all State or local government employee associations operating in the State to attend. 18 19 (3) Give a State or local government employee association preferential treatment through procedures, policies, or any other means. 20 21 Endorse one State or local government employee association over another. (4) 22 Refer to days or breaks in the employment calendar by the name of a State (5)or local government employee association. 23 24 A State or local government employer shall not discourage or prohibit a State or local government employee from joining a State or local government employee association or 25 showing preferences toward any State or local government employee association." 26 27 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective September 1, 2011.".
