moves to amend the bill on page 3, lines 11-14, by rewriting the lines to read:

"SECTION 2.(a) There is appropriated to Statewide Reserves the sum of seventeen million five hundred thousand dollars (\$17,500,000) for payment to the Escheat Fund. The Office of State Budget and Management shall remit to the Escheat Fund the sum of seventeen million five hundred thousand dollars (\$17,500,000) as payment on the outstanding loan from the Escheat Fund to the Global TransPark Authority authorized under G.S. 63A-4(a)(22) and G.S. 147-69.2(b)(11).";

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And on page 3, line 23, by deleting the sentence that begins with "Notwithstanding";

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16 17 And on page 3, lines 27-28, by inserting the following new section between the lines:

"SECTION 2.(c) If House Bill 200 of the 2011 Regular Session becomes law, then Section 2.1 of that act reads as rewritten:

'SECTION 2.1. Appropriations from the General Fund of the State for the maintenance of the State departments, institutions, and agencies, and for other purposes as enumerated, are made for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2013, according to the following schedule:
