Senator Tillman

1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 28 through page 2, line 35 by deleting the section and  
2 inserting the following language:

'''SECTION 4. G.S. 20-63(h) reads as rewritten:

'(h) Commission Contracts for Issuance of Plates and Certificates. – All registration  
6 plates, registration certificates, and certificates of title issued by the Division, outside of those  
7 issued from the Charlotte and Raleigh offices of the Division and those issued and handled  
8 through the United States mail, shall be issued insofar as practicable and possible through  
9 commission contracts entered into by the Division for the issuance of the plates and certificates  
10 in localities throughout North ~~Carolina~~-Carolina, including military installations within this  
11 State, with persons, firms, corporations or governmental subdivisions of the State of North  
12 Carolina. The Division shall make a reasonable effort in every locality, except as noted above,  
13 to enter into a commission contract for the issuance of the plates and certificates and a record of  
14 these efforts shall be maintained in the Division. In the event the Division is unsuccessful in  
15 making commission contracts, it shall issue the plates and certificates through the regular  
16 employees of the Division. Whenever registration plates, registration certificates, and  
17 certificates of title are issued by the Division through commission contract arrangements, the  
18 Division shall provide proper supervision of the distribution. Nothing contained in this  
19 subsection will allow or permit the operation of fewer outlets in any county in this State than  
20 are now being operated.

Commission contracts entered into by the Division under this subsection shall provide for  
22 the payment of compensation on a per transaction basis. The collection of the highway use tax  
23 shall be considered a separate transaction for which one dollar and twenty-seven cents (\$1.27)  
24 compensation shall be paid. The performance at the same time of one or more of the remaining  
25 transactions listed in this subsection shall be considered a single transaction for which one  
26 dollar and forty-three cents (\$1.43) compensation shall be paid.


