- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 11-15 by rewriting those lines to read:
- 2 "SECTION 3. The Department of Correction shall study the potential benefits and
- 3 costs of contracting for maintenance services at prison facilities and report its findings to the
- 4 2011 Regular Session of the General Assembly on the date of its reconvening in 2012. The
- 5 Department shall not expand private maintenance contracts to additional prison facilities prior
- 6 to July 1, 2012.
- 7 SECTION 3.1. If House Bill 200, 2011 Regular Session becomes law, then
- 8 effective January 1, 2012, Section 3 of this act reads as rewritten:
- 9 "SECTION 3. The Department of ~~Correction~~ Public Safety shall study the
- 10 potential benefits and costs of contracting for maintenance services at prison facilities and
- 11 report its findings to the 2011 Regular Session of the General Assembly on the date of its
- 12 reconvening in 2012. The Department shall not expand private maintenance contracts to
- 13 additional prison facilities prior to July 1, 2012.""
